

What is a typical service like at the Anglican Church of Livonia?

Dress is casual, fancy and everything in between.

Music includes contemporary praise, gospel songs, and great hymns from through the ages.

All words to music and all the prayers are written out in the bulletin for the 10am service making it easy for anyone to participate.

Service is made up of two main parts.

The first part of the service centers on God's word to us through the Bible. Every Sunday we have a reading from God's history with the Jews (the Old Testament), a reading from the letters of the Apostles to the early churches (the New Testament), and from the story of Jesus' life and ministry (the Gospels). After the readings our minister preaches a 15-20 minute sermon on how God's Word is applied to our lives in 21st century America.

The Second half of the service is a celebration of God's gift of new life to us through Jesus' death on the cross to take away our sins. At this celebration of the Lord's Supper we give ourselves to God and receive Him as we drink the wine and eat the bread as Jesus commanded us to do.
